## Fixed Fees

For those clients who wish to budget for costs, we have developed a competitive fixed fee scheme. Not all work is suitable for Fixed Fees.

Fixed fees allow you to instruct a solicitor to do a piece of work for you in the certain knowledge of how much it will cost you.

In some cases, this will be stage by stage and in other matters this may be a single fixed fee.

For example we may agree to chase a debt for a fixed fee. Alternatively we may agree a fixed fee for a simple contractual matter.

In more complex cases we will break down the various stages of the case and we then charge a fixed fee per stage. This doesn't mean that you will never pay an hourly cost because certain items may be hourly simply because we can't reasonably foresee a particular step such as how long particular negotiation may take. In other cases, negotiation will be included because it can be limited (i.e. Negotiation with Counterparties up to 4 hours thereafter hourly charges apply).

In some cases, you might prefer to deal with aspects of your case yourself and instruct your solicitor under a fixed fee agreement to deal with other parts.

You will not get itemized billing for fixed fees and under fixed fees, the entire fee (or if staged fees are provided, the staged fee) is payable as soon as work starts.
